Clearly Captain slow wasn't too disheartened by this!

An interest race was on our hands but it was clearly going to be very one sided. Clarkson tought about makin them observation that if he was on the same plan as Captain Slow he would have still been first at the Leipzig event but thought better of it! There would be plenty of time over the weekend to be his typically obnoxious self! 





Both Captain Slow and I had an excellent trip and enjoyed ourselves in Berlin. I'll share a few highlights below.




